

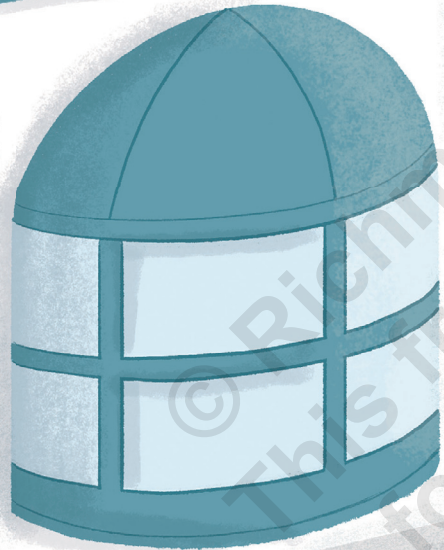
# Jolly Can't Play

We can do many things that are fun.

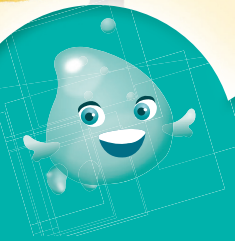
